## ORDER REQUIRING DEFENDANTS TO PAY SANCTIONS

For reasons stated on the record of proceedings on this date and as provided in the Order Re: Spoliation Sanctions:

- 1. Defendants Mark Pappas and Creative Pipe, Inc. shall, by 5:00 P.M., Friday, November 5, 2010, pay Plaintiff the amount of \$337,796.37 constituting the minimum amount of sanctions imposed by said Order.
  - a. Said payment shall be made to counsel for Plaintiff, Randall C. Ogg, Esquire for Plaintiff.
  - b. Payment shall be effected by delivery of certified check, wire transfer or equivalent means of effecting transfer of funds.
- 2. If said payment is not made, the said Defendants shall appear in Courtroom 5C of the United States Courthouse in Baltimore on November 8, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. to show cause why they should not be held in civil contempt for their failure to comply with said Order.
  - a. Defendant Mark Pappas shall appear in person and Defendant Creative Pipe, Inc. shall appear by counsel.

b. If Defendant Mark Pappas does not comply with paragraph 1 and also fails to appear in compliance with paragraph 2 hereof, a warrant may be issued for his arrest so that he shall be brought before the Court as soon as may be practicable.
