ORDER

AND NOW, this 18th day of February, 2016, pursuant to the accompanying memorandum, it is ORDERED that:

1. Defendants' Motion for Protective Order (Doc. 63) is DENIED. Plaintiff may depose Renata Moseley as to the steps taken and facts learned during her the course of her investigation.
2. Defendants' Motion *in Limine* (Doc. 65) is GRANTED. The emails that are Bates Stamped McSparran 1738 to McSparran 1807 are excluded.
3. Plaintiff's request to amend our prior order (Doc. 67) is GRANTED. Plaintiff is not required to produce metadata associated with electronic information produced in response to Defendants' first and second requests for production of documents.
4. The discovery deadline is extended until Friday, March 25, 2016. Defendants' Motion to Extend Time for Plaintiff's Deposition (Doc. 75) is DISMISSED AS MOOT.
